

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OF THE YANBOX.COM SERVICE

The owner of the **yanbox.com** service is **Yanosik S.A.**, with its address at **Kurfürstendamm 96, 10709 Berlin, Germany** (hereinafter: “we”, “us”, the “Company”). The Company acts as the controller of personal data within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (GDPR).

In connection with the User’s use of the Service, information about the User’s activity in the Service is collected. The following categories of personal data are processed: technical data (IP address, browser type, operating system), data on activity in the Service (browsing history, user preferences), data contained in cookies, and other data voluntarily provided by the User.

The controller of data concerning the User’s activity in the Service is the Company, which processes personal data for the purpose of:

1. enabling Users to use the Service in connection with making available content collected in the Service and providing services available within the Service on the basis of an agreement for the provision of electronic services and/or an agreement for the supply of digital content or digital services (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR);
2. using necessary cookies in connection with providing Users with services and functionalities of the Service which the User wishes to use on the basis of the concluded agreement for the provision of electronic services (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR);
3. ensuring the security of the Service and improving the functionality of the Service based on system log records, which constitutes the legitimate interest of the Controller consisting in protecting its rights and interests (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR);
4. potential establishment and pursuit of claims or defence against claims, in connection with the Company’s legitimate interest consisting in protecting its rights and interests (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR);
5. using functional, analytical and marketing cookies in connection with consent expressed via the CookieYes tool, which constitutes the Company’s legitimate interest consisting in ensuring the highest quality of services provided in the Service and improving and developing the functionality of the Company’s products and services (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR);
6. fulfilling legal obligations incumbent on the Controller (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR);
7. keeping statistics and analyses concerning the functioning of the Service within the scope of legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).

The User’s personal data will be processed by us for the duration of the provision of the service, until an objection to the processing of data is raised, but no longer than until the expiry of the limitation periods for

asserting claims related to the processing of data for the purposes listed above and/or until the expiry of periods resulting from legal provisions.

Providing personal data is voluntary; however, refusal to provide it results in the inability to use the Service with regard to its basic functionalities.

Personal data is not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

Personal data may be transferred to:

- our subcontractors, e.g. external entities providing services to us;
- public authorities – to the extent they are authorised to receive it under the law.

In connection with the processing of personal data, under the terms set out in the GDPR, the User has the right to:

- request access to personal data and rectification thereof;
- request erasure of personal data;
- request restriction of the processing of personal data;
- object to the processing of personal data.

In order to exercise the right referred to above, please contact our Data Protection Officer in the manner described above.

If the User considers that personal data is not processed in compliance with the law, the User has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Poland).

As a rule, we do not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area. However, we may entrust the performance of certain services to subcontractors based outside the European Economic Area, e.g. in the area of IT services and tools. In such a case, personal data will be transferred to a third country for which an adequate level of data protection has been confirmed by a decision of the European Commission or on the basis of Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.

This information may be updated. Users will be informed of material changes via the Service.
